

Jog-a-thon K-6th / Bowl-a-thon 7th & 8th grade

These events are the major fundraising events that PSA (Parish School Association) holds each school year. In order to sponsor events through out the year PSA hopes to raise an average of \$50.00 or more per student. Pledges are solicited by students for the laps they jog or total bowling game score. Students have found it to **their** advantage to solicit a total dollar amount from a sponsor so that they can collect at the time of the sponsorship and not have to return. Parents are asked for food donations or to volunteer time on the day of the event to help run the event.

Tee Shirt & Sweatshirts

These items are sold by PSA to help students show school spirit. Tee shirts & sweatshirts may be worn on Crusader Days (Usually 1st Friday of the month) and sweatshirts may be worn as part of the school uniform. Volunteers are needed to take orders, collect money and distribute orders through out the school year.

Popcorn

Popcorn is popped/bagged and sold on Thursday to the students. Volunteers are needed in the morning to pop/bag and **take orders from** the students.

Santa's Secret Shop

Students are given the opportunity to purchase Christmas gifts for friends and family on their own. Prices vary from under \$1.00 and up. Volunteer opportunities exist in the set up / take down of the event, and during the school day sale hours assisting students, wrapping of items, inventory and cashiering.

Kids Movie Night Out

Movies are shown in the Activity Center on a Friday or Saturday night. Parents may drop off their children, pizza and snack type items are offered for sale. Volunteers are needed to plan the event, set up / take down, work in the foodservice area and to supervise. **This is a fundraiser.**

Daddy/Daughter Dance

Fathers and their daughter(s) enjoy a night out together. Event is held in the Activity Center. Volunteers are needed to plan, set up /take down and work the event.

Mother/ Son Dance

Mothers and their son(s) enjoy a night out together. Event is held in the activity center. Volunteers are needed to plan, set up/take down and work the event.

Scholastic Book Fair

Scholastic Books and other items are offered for sale to the students. Volunteers are needed to plan, set up /take down and work the event during the school day. Volunteers assist students and collect money.

Catholic Schools Week

Fun filled week with each day having a different theme such as: Teacher Appreciation Day/Student Appreciation Day and Sports Day. Surprises, games and treats are planned throughout the week to celebrate our Catholic Education. **Volunteers are needed to plan this week long celebration of Catholic schools education.**

Special Persons Day

A day where students are encouraged to have a guest/guests visit them at school. Usually the day starts with a continental breakfast for the guest, an all school mass, and class room visits. Volunteers are needed to plan, set up/take down and work the event during various activities.

Science Night

Science Night is a parish out reach activity sponsored by PSA. This event is usually held in the activity center during the evening. The Ann Arbor Hands on Museum sets up different “Hands on” Activities for the children to experience. Volunteers are needed to plan, set up/take down and work during the event. A can donation is usually requested for admission and donated to a local food bank.

Catholic Book Fair

Religious books and other items are offered for sale to the students much like the Scholastic book fair only in a religious context. The Catholic book fair is usually held during lent and one other time during the year provided support and volunteers are available. This book fair is usually held in the small meeting room by activity center and includes hours over the weekend for parishioners after masses. Volunteers are needed to plan, set up /take down and work the event during the school day. Volunteers assist students and collect money.

Euchre Tournament

This is a parish out reach activity which is usually held on a Saturday night in the activity center. Participants are encouraged to have an evening full of fun playing euchre. Volunteers are needed to plan, set up/take down and work the event.

Special Events

Special events such as assemblies are planned for the students through out the year during the school day. These events are usually held once per month and the cost is fully covered by PSA. Volunteers are needed to plan, and on occasion set up/ take down.

Market Days

Parents have the opportunity to order food items through the Market Day program. Orders are placed on the internet and picked up at school usually the 1st Wednesday of the month. Fliers are sent home with students. Volunteers are needed to set up the program, and work delivery day and during pick up hours.

Birthday Train

A program designated to help the library acquire books. Parents make a donation for a book, and the student is honored on their birthday with a book donated in their name. The book is taken home by the student for two weeks **to be returned** and added to our library collection. Volunteers are need to plan and coordinate the event

Christmas Parish Lunch

A PSA sponsored Christmas lunch for school and parish staff. Volunteers needed to plan, coordinate, cook/obtain food donations and set up/take down.

8th Grade Graduation

Volunteers needed to plan, coordinate, graduation dinner/banquet, set up/take down.

Fall Teacher Conference

Provide lunch for school staff during parent conferences. Volunteers needed to set up/take down, coordinate event.

Roller Skating party Fall/Spring

Roller skating party at Bonaventure for all grades pre- Thanksgiving and pre-Easter break. Volunteers need to coordinate and plan event.

Teacher Appreciation Lunch

Held during National Teacher Appreciation week, the first full week in May. Volunteers needed to plan, coordinate, and set up/take down a lunch for the school staff.

Used Uniform Sale

Plan and coordinate the used uniform sale held through out the school year. Volunteers needed to work during the sale or set up/take down. **This event is usually held in August, before start of school as well as spring sometime.**

Crusader Day Hot Dog Sale

Usually held the 1st Friday each month. Students purchase hot dogs for lunch with the proceeds donated to the 5th grade to offset the cost of attending the Outdoor Center. Plan, coordinate the cooking and delivery of hot dogs to students.

Art Fair / Ice Cream Social

Held near the end of the school year. Students' art projects are displayed through out the school for viewing pleasure. Ice cream sundaes are provides by PSA. Volunteers needed to coordinate, plan, setup/take down art projects with the Art teacher and service ice cream station.

Fun Day

An all day event planned during the final week of school, volunteers needed to plan, coordinate games, lunch and provide supervision to the students.
